

Membership fees for Princeton Athletic Club as revised September 24, 2013

These are the membership fees for 2014. The fee structure is intended to apply in future years, with the upcoming year substituted for 2014 and the current year substituted for 2013.

PAC encourages members of the club to contribute to the organization by crewing at least one club event per year. There may be ongoing activities requiring substantial resources with other service incentives. Free membership is available to those members who regularly contribute their time to the upkeep of the organization.

The unit of membership is the household. Dues for 2014 as follows.

Individual option A	\$25 Includes (non-duplicative) PAC T-shirt.
Individual option B	\$15 after 8/31/2014 – includes (non-duplicative) PAC T-shirt. *** Not available to 2013 PAC members. ***
Additional adult (19+) – must be in same household – same as above, less \$5.	
Individual option C	\$0 plus service in 2013 including: <i>directing an event</i> , or three times a <i>preregistered crew member at a race</i> . Includes (non-duplicative) PAC T-shirt. *** Available only to 2013 PAC members. ***
Children (under 19)	\$10 for all – any number of children in the same household as an individual member. Does not include jersey or T-shirt.
PAC jersey	\$48.25 approximate – must be current or joining PAC member.

PAC may absorb online processing costs associated with the above.

DIRECT AN EVENT means be responsible for an event as described in the race director job description in Appendix A to the Bylaws of PAC. Note that there are occasional events that are not races. There may be a race series where the series coordinator, not the event manager of the day, is responsible for fulfilling the race director job description.

PREREGISTERED CREW MEMBER means signing up in advance for an event crew.

Signing up in advance means committing to the position and informing the race director by the usual means of recorded crew sign-up at least two weeks prior to the event. Eligible crew assist agree to assist for at least two hours if the needs of the event so indicate.

The usual method of sign-up has recently been online registration via active.com.

RACE means a running event that caters to the general public which provides an opportunity for competition and where results are recorded. The race should be open to as wide a range of age and ability as possible subject to safety requirements. The race director is the person charged with fulfilling the responsibilities in the race director role description.

At events where it is possible for crew to also race, e.g. track events, eligible crew assist with the understanding that priority is to the functioning of the event over the individual opportunity to race. For road and trail events, the usual expectation for eligible crew would be filling roles while the race is live.

The credit for crewing an event is not transferable from one person to another.
