

These standing policies are subject to revision by ordinary action of the Princeton Athletic Club board.

Board review of event plans for repeating events – adopted June 24, 2018

When a proposed event is substantially a repetition of a previous PAC event and the proposed event director has previously directed an event at a similar level of organization, the board may review and approve the event by electronic communication and report the approval at the following board meeting.

Membership fees – revised September 24, 2013

First person in a household, joining January 1 to August 31, for remainder of the calendar year, \$25. After August 31, membership fee is \$40 for the remainder of the calendar year and the following calendar year. At the convenience of the Board, approximately November 1, the membership fee is \$25 for the remainder of the calendar year and the following calendar year.

Service option. For a person who directed an event in the preceding calendar year or who signed up and performed as a preregistered crew member at three races in the preceding calendar year, the membership fee is \$0.

Additional adult in a household, same dates as above, \$20 for the calendar year and \$30 for fall plus following year.

All under-19's after the first person in a household, same dates as above, \$10 for the calendar year and \$20 for fall plus following year.

PAC may absorb online processing costs associated with the above.

HOUSEHOLD means adults and their dependents who reside at the same street address.

DIRECT AN EVENT means be responsible for an event as described in the race director job description in Appendix A to the Bylaws of PAC. Note that there are occasional events that are not races. There may be a race series where the series coordinator, not the event manager of the day, is responsible for fulfilling the race director job description.

PREREGISTERED CREW MEMBER means signing up in advance for an event crew.

Signing up in advance means committing to the position and informing the race director by the usual means of recorded crew sign-up at least two weeks prior to the event. Eligible crew assist agree to assist for at least two hours if the needs of the event so indicate.

The usual method of sign-up has recently been online registration via active.com.

RACE means a running event that caters to the general public which provides an opportunity for competition and where results are recorded. The race should be open to as wide a range of age and ability as possible subject to safety requirements. The race director is the person charged with fulfilling the responsibilities in the race director role description.

At events where it is possible for crew to also race, e.g. track events, eligible crew assist with the understanding that priority is to the functioning of the event over the individual opportunity to race. For road and trail events, the usual expectation for eligible crew would be filling roles while the race is live.

The credit for crewing an event is not transferable from one person to another.
